- To allow growth of individuals by nurturing and focusing on the development process.

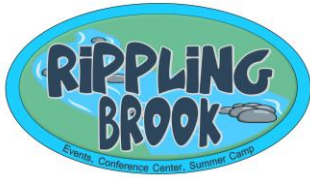
Our Camper Goals: Build a community, create memories, try new things, have fun!
